## **Vehicle Purchased at Auction with No Title Consultation and Court-Ordered Title in New Jersey**

### **Consultation with Title Expert**

Nelson contacted CarTitles to schedule a consultation with a Title Expert. During the 30-minute consultation, Nelson explained that he buys used cars in the United States and ships them internationally to be sold abroad. He had purchased a vehicle via a Blue Light auction with Copart, and the vehicle was sold without a title. The Title Expert from CarTitles advised Nelson that his best path forward was to use the Court-Ordered Title process to obtain a title. While New Jersey has a procedure for obtaining a car title called the Insufficient Evidence of Title Process, the Title Expert determined that this method was unlikely to be successful due to the history of the vehicle and the nature of the purchase.

## Vehicle Purchased at Auction with No Title Consultation and Court-Ordered Title in New Jersey

### Nelson's Court-Ordered Title Process (*Paperwork Only Service*)

Nelson elected to move forward with a Court-Ordered Title with CarTitles. After completing the Vehicle Title Information form on the CarTitles website, he was sent a packet of information on obtaining a title through the Court-Ordered Title process. After he received the folder containing all the documents necessary to complete a Court-Ordered Title process, Nelson filled out the paperwork. In addition to the documents provided by CarTitles, he included some supporting documentation.

At this time, he contacted CarTitles to ask questions about the documents provided and learn about the different forms provided. **He used the documents provided by CarTitles to “tell” his story** of how he acquired the car and the steps he had taken to try to obtain a title. Once completed, he mailed the information to the court. A short time later, the court responded with a request to pay the court fees.

Nelson went to the court personally to pay the court fees, where he had a **“delightful”** conversation with the employees of the court. He was further advised to send a letter containing the court documents to the NJDMV and to obtain some additional documentation.

### Receiving a Judgment and Obtaining a Title

Once these steps were completed, he mailed all the documents to the court. The court provided a judgment, which he then mailed to the NJMVC headquarters with the Title Application filled in and provided by CarTitles in the original document packet.

**The entire process took Nelson 75 days** from the initial consultation to getting the title from the NJDMV. *This timeframe included the winter holiday when the court and NJDMV were not open or working at a limited capacity.*

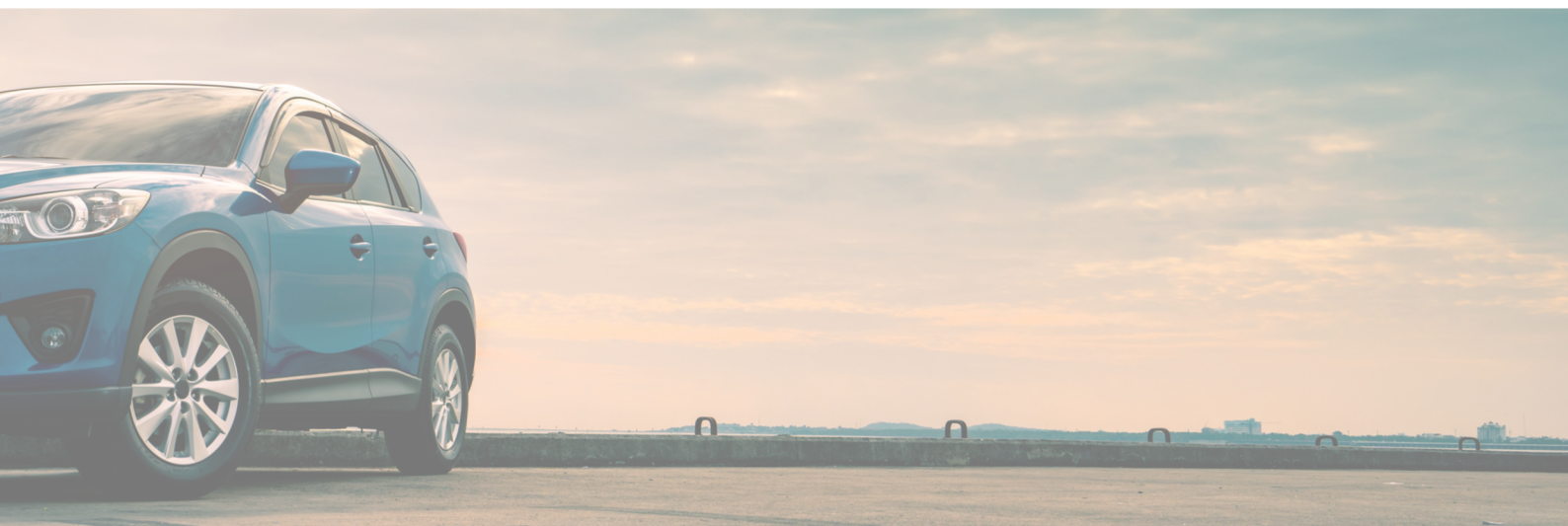
